



Take-a-Kid Fishing Tournament in Inukjuak First Edition a Great Success!

In Inukjuak on August 18, the Kativik Regional Police Force organized the first ever Take-a-Kid Fishing Tournament. Fifty-eight teams composed of one adult and one child (person under the age of 16) participated in this friendly competition. At the end of the day, the teams returned with their entire catch to the weigh-in station. Three species of catches were eligible: arctic char, lake trout and brook trout. First prize was awarded to the angler with the catch that came closest to a mystery weight decided by the tournament organizers prior to the event. The winners in the brook trout category were Minnie Nowkawalk and Lisi Tina Nowkawalk. In the lake trout category, the winners were Simon Ningiuk and Saumik Qautuk. No arctic char were caught.

A barbecue was organized for participants following the tournament at which time a boat safety message and demonstration of the proper use of lifejackets were delivered. Other prizes were also raffled off.
