



CALL FOR CULTURAL PERFORMERS

Team Nunavik-Québec

INFORMATION

The Kativik Regional Government (KRG) is inviting Nunavik youth to submit an application to participate in the cultural program at the Arctic Winter Games in Hay River and Fort Smith, Northwest Territories in March 2018.

The Games are a great occasion to bring together bright and young artists from each contingent to share their talents, originality and creativity with the community and other games participants. It is also an opportunity for participants to perform in a variety of settings in a Games environment.

The team will be comprised of a maximum of six (6) performing artists plus a Coordinator and a Chaperone.

CRITERIA:

To be eligible, interested candidates must:

- Be born between 1997 and 2003.
- Be a non-professional artist (not using their artistic ability as their only source of income).
- Agree to be present for the entire duration of the Games (March 17 – 24, 2018 plus travel days).
- Abide by all the rules of your team and the host society.
- Work cooperatively in a team environment.

EXPECTATIONS PRIOR TO THE GAMES:

Once selected and notified by the KRG Recreation Department, candidates must:

- Provide all necessary information for travel within and outside of Nunavik.
- Complete the team AWG registration form and send all supporting documentation required by the Chef-de-Mission (i.e. health card number, passport, etc.).
- Be available for trainings and practices with other members of the Cultural Team.
- Prepare various lengths of their performance; ideally in lengths of five minutes, ten minutes, and twenty minutes.

EXPECTATIONS AT THE GAMES:

The Team Nunavik-Québec cultural team will:

- Perform publicly once a day as scheduled and determined by the Host Society – i.e. award ceremonies, games venues, athletes' village and community venues.
- Participate in all activities including workshops and rehearsals prepared by the Host Society.
- Possibly to take part in gala performance(s).

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Fill out an application form and send it back to the KRG Kuujuaq office by the deadline.

- Applications are available from the KRG website (www.krg.ca) or by contacting Karin Kettler (see contact below).
- Applications must be returned by fax (819-254-8763) or by e-mail (kkettler@krg.ca).

2. Applications will be reviewed and validated by KRG.

3. References will be checked in the final process by KRG.

4. Applicants will receive a letter of notification.

DEADLINE: Friday, September 22, 2017 at 5:00pm.
