In order to recognize the outstanding commitment of seniors who voluntarily contribute to improving the quality of living and social participation of seniors in their communities, the Minister responsible for Seniors and Anti-Bullying, Francine Charbonneau, issued on May 15 a call for nominations for the Prix Hommage Aînés 2017.

The Nunavik Elders' Committee will be collecting nominations **until June 15, 2017**, at which point they will be submitted to an independent selection committee. The Nunavik Elders' Committee is subsequently responsible for recommending an award recipient for the region.
