### A New KRG Council and Executive Committee

**Kuujuaq, Québec – November 25, 2009** – Last night, the newly formed Council of the Kativik Regional Government (KRG) appointed from among its municipal elected representatives a new Executive Committee. The Executive Committee is responsible for the management of the affairs of the KRG and ensures that the decisions of the KRG Council are carried out. The five members, who were all chosen by acclamation, are:
