



*Nunavik Parks is dedicated to protecting exceptional features of the natural environment and representative landscapes from encroaching human activity that includes non-renewable resource exploitation. National park protection focuses on conservation through enhanced educational and recreational opportunities for Nunavimmiut and travellers from around the world. In Nunavik's national parks, Inuit maintain their right to practise subsistence harvesting activities. In fact, the practice of traditional activities form part of the region's unique park experience.*

*The Kativik Regional Government is a public organization created in 1978 under the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement. The organization has jurisdiction over nearly the entire territory of Québec north of the 55th parallel in areas such as municipal matters, transportation, the environment, policing, employment, labour training, income security, childcare services, renewable resources, land-use planning, civil security and economic development.*
