NTA is looking for a motivated and dynamic person to act as a tourism development officer in the region of Nunavik. With the regional tourism stakeholders, the tourism development officer will work with promoters, economic development corporations and other tourism stakeholders, in order to:

- Help develop sustainable tourism activities, products and practices in Nunavik
- Implement the Nunavik Sustainable Tourism Strategy

#### Main tasks:

- 1- GIVE SUPPORT TO COMMUNITIES AND TO ENTREPRENEURS:
  - Accompany communities and businesses in their tourism development projects
  - Identify opportunities and sources of funding
  - Help the communities and the businesses in the implementation of best practices in tourism (customer experience, risk management, visitor readiness and sustainable tourism).
- 2- TOURISM COORDINATION:
  - Lead or participate in tourism projects developed in collaboration with regional partners
  - Collaborate with NTA marketing director when required
  - Represent the organization at events and meetings when required (meetings, regional events, launches, trade shows, galas, etc.)
