

# JOB DESCRIPTION 3rd Cook - Day

**Summary**: Reporting directly to the Production Manager, the duties of the **3rd Cook - Day** are to assist the 2° cook in production. He/she must ensure that the necessary menu items are prepared, that they are complete, that follow-up is carried out and that the food meets quality standards. The 3° cook must be able to work under pressure, manage time well and have a positive attitude.

## **Responsibilities**

The duties and responsibilities of the person occupying the position of **3rd Cook - Day** include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following tasks:

- Assist the 2nd Cook with production;
- Help produce side dishes and salad bars;
- Prepare raw vegetables and fruit;
- Ensure that all necessary preparation is carried out, recorded and meets quality standards;
- Participate in cleaning and maintaining the cleanliness of the kitchen and service areas;
- Ensure proper food storage and rotation;
- Ensure that all tasks are carried out safely, and report any incidents or problems immediately. Don't miss
  out, act now;
- All other tasks as required.

#### **Qualifications and requirements**

- Diploma in hotel management, catering, or equivalent combination of technical training and/or related experience;
- A minimum of 1 year experience in the kitchen;
- Experience in regional or remote labor camps is an asset;
- French-English bilingualism is considered an asset.
