Conveniently located near the Pierre Elliot Trudeau International Airport, the beautifully decorated three-story complex with 90 rooms and 145 beds ensures the comfort and well-being of its Inuit users by offering relaxation areas, common rooms, meeting spaces for families, and a cafeteria.
