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Application Form Instructions

Because the cost of living in Nunavik is very high, the Kativik Regional Government (KRG), the Makivik Corporation and the Québec government have undertaken to offer assistance to Nunavimmiut. The harvesting vehicle and equipment component of the Program supports costs for vehicles and equipment used for subsistence hunting, fishing, trapping and gathering activities.

► Who is eligible?

Anyone who is aged at least 18 as of January 1 of the application year, has been a resident of Nunavik for at least 12 consecutive months, and is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA) is eligible under the harvesting vehicle and equipment component of the Program. The sales receipt, invoice or contract must indicate the name of the subsidy applicant.

How long do I have to apply?

This form must be submitted to the KRG Finance Department no later than 120 days following the date of purchase.

What items are covered?

- Boat
- Snowmobile Freighter canoe
- Outboard motor Boggan
- Boat trailer

 Ice Auger • All-terrain vehicle (ATV) • Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) Locally built gajag

- Qamutiik
- Transportation for snowmobile, outboard

No minimum purchase and been acquired from a recognized retailer.

What is the amount of the subsidy?

The harvesting vehicle and equipment component of the Program provides a 40% subsidy on the value of each eligible purchase. There is no minimum purchase value per item. The maximum subsidy per item is \$1,150 since September 1, 2020. There is no maximum annual cumulative amount payable per subsidy applicant.

The costs to ship snowmobiles, outboard motors, ATV's and UTV's south for repairs are subsidized up to a maximum value of \$1000 for southbound transport and \$1000 for northbound transport. Eligible applicants may claim one return shipment annually.

How do I apply?

This application form must be completely and properly filled out and mailed to the KRG. Each application form must include copies of:

- your sales receipt, invoice or contract;
- the shipping invoice to your community, if the item was purchased outside of Nunavik;
- valid personal identification indicating your date of birth;
- your JBNQA beneficiary card issued by the Makivik Corporation.

This program may be modified or suspended at any time.

► IMPORTANT!

Before mailing this document, make sure that you have:

- O Completely and accurately filled out, signed and dated your application form.
- O Completed the attestation of residency section on your application form.
- O Attached a copy of your sales receipt, invoice or contract.
- O Attached a copy of the shipping invoice (airfreight or sealift) to your community, if the item was purchased outside of Nunavik.
- O Attached a copy of valid personal identification indicating your date of birth (health card, driver's licence or other).
- O Attached a copy of your JBNQA beneficiary card.
